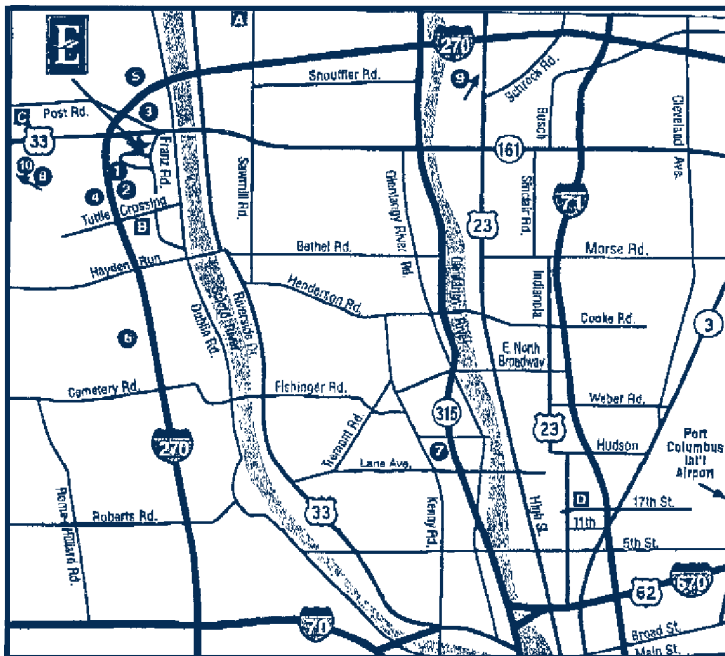

Ohio Legislation and Your Practice: *presented by Lynn R. Watchman, Senator, State of Ohio, Chairman of the Health, Human Services and Aging Committee*

Senator Wachtmann will provide you with insights into current legislation that his committee is working on. In addition he will be answering any questions you may have about current legislation as well as listening to your concerns and comments regarding the specific problems that affect the practice of medicine in Ohio. He is also interested in hearing from you as medical administrators about the Prompt Pay (bumper bill) and what your perspective is on Medicaid and effects that the prompt pay bill has had. So come prepared with any questions that you need and explained. This is a great opportunity to meet and converse with a state legislative leader

Senator Wachtmann is a former Napoleon City Councilman and State Representative. He served for seven terms in the Ohio House of Representatives, from 1985-1998. He was sworn in the Ohio Senate on January 4, 1999 as State Senator for the 1st District.

Senator Wachtmann serves on four committees. He is the Chairman of Health, Human Services and Aging Committee and a member of Highways and Transportation, Ways and Means, and Judiciary - Civil Justice committees. All four committees have a significant impact on the 1st District and he is working for a positive impact for our district and our state.
